The Claggett Center is the Episcopal Diocese of Maryland's retreat, camp and conference center. Claggett offers space for a wide variety of diocesan events, including vestry and ministry retreats, programs for musicians, women, men and youth, and flagship events such as the Chapman Dialogues and Clergy Conference. From hosted groups to original programming, Claggett serves as a place of common ground for the diocese.



The 266-acre property sits on a scenic bluff overlooking Sugarloaf Mountain and the Monocacy River Valley, creating a serene and beautiful backdrop perfect for learning, growth, and spirit-filled renewal.

Claggett Center features 3,000 square feet of dedicated meeting space and a variety of comfortable sleeping rooms to accommodate various kinds of groups.
