Who We Are

Within the past three years the Diocese has actively supported four new congregational ministries.

Church on the Square is a joint mission of the Diocese and the Delaware-Maryland Synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America. It is located in the Canton neighborhood of Baltimore, a destination of many young adults. An Episcopal priest and lay leader work out of a strategically-located church formerly occupied by a Lutheran congregation. The Episcopal Church awarded a Mission Enterprise Zone matching grant to help launch this congregation.



The Slate Project in north Baltimore seeks seekers both in person and online. It was started by a Lutheran pastor who asked the question, “What if we had a blank slate for being and doing church?” They gather weekly at the Cathedral of the Incarnation for their #BreakingBread dinner church as well as online with a weekly #SlateSpeak chat on Twitter and share original videos on their YouTube channel. The Diocese is now supporting this new ministry with a part time co-pastor.

St. Hilda's is the newest Episcopal congregation in the Diocese. It shares a vicar/senior pastor and a building in Catonsville with New Hope Community Church. This partnership offers members of both congregations to share in Bible study, Sunday school, outreach and fellowship, while worshipping in their own traditions.

St. Andrew's International Community Church/Anglican-Episcopal worships in Baltimore at a church that had been vacant. They are mostly immigrants from Africa who are led by an Anglican priest as well as a Pentecostal pastor. Two services are offered; an Episcopal Holy Eucharist early Sunday with a Pentecostal service at midday. The Diocese is supporting this ministry in partnership with an Anglican diocese in Kenya.
